



# Pumpkin Hat

Size 3-6 months

## Overview

Equipment	
Needles	3.5mm and 4.5mm needles for knitting in the round
Wool	Orange medium weight (double knit) Green for the stem
Crochet hook	Any size for the stem

## Key of abbreviations

CO	Cast On
P	Purl
K	Knit
P2tog	Purl two together
K2tog	Knit two together
K3tog	Knit three together

# **Hat Rim**

For 3-6 month hat CO 72 stitches on 3.5mm needles.

Follow a K2, P2 rib stitch until the rim measures 2cm from CO.

# **Body**

(P6, K1, P8, K1) x4, P7, K1

Repeat this row until it measures 9cm from CO.

# **Decrease**

Decrease over 19 rows

1. P6, K1, P4 P2tog P2, K1, P4 P2tog, K1, P4 P2tog P2, K1, P6, K1, P4 P2tog P2, K1, P6, K1, P4 P2tog P2, K1, P4 P2tog P1, K1 (66 Stitches)
2. P6, K1, P7, K1, P5, K1, P7, K1, P6, K1, P7, K1, P6, K1, P7, K1, P6, K1
3. P4 P2tog, K1, P4 P2tog P1, K1, P5, K1, P4 P2tog P1, K1, P4 P2tog, K1, P4 P2tog P1, K1, P6, K1, P4 P2tog P1, K1, P6, K1 (60 Stitches)
4. P5, K1, P6, K1, P5, K1, P6, K1, P5, K1, P6, K1, P6, K1, P6, K1, P6, K1

6. P5, K1, P5, K1, P4, K1, P5, K1, P5, K1, P5, K1, P6, K1, P5, K1, P5, K1
7. P3 P2tog, K1, P3 P2tog, K1, P4, K1, P3 P2tog, K1, P5, K1, P3 P2tog,, K1, P4 P2tog, K1, P5, K1, P3 P2tog, K1 (48 Stitches)
8. P4, K1, P4, K1, P4, K1, P4, K1, P5, K1 ,P4, K1, P5, K1, P5, K1, P4, K1
9. P2 P2tog, K1, P4, K1, P2 P2tog,, K1, P2 P2tog,, K1, P3 P2tog,, K1, P4, K1, P3 P2tog,, K1, P5, K1, P2 P2tog, K1 (42 Stitches)
10. P3, K1, P4, K1, P3, K1, P3, K1, P4, K1, P4, K1, P4, K1, P5, K1, P3, K1

11. P1 P2tog, K1, P2 P2tog, K1, P3, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P4, K1, P2 P2tog, K1, P2 P2tog, K1, P3 P2tog, K1, P3, K1  
K1 (36 Stitches)
12. P2, K1, P3, K1, P3, K1, P2, K1, P4, K1, P3, K1, P3, K1, P4, K1, P3, K1
13. P2, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P2, K1, P2 P2tog, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P1 P2tog,, K1, P2 P2tog, K1, P3, K1  
(30 Stitches)
14. P2, K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, P3, K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, P3, K1, P3, K1
15. P2, K1, P2tog, K1, P2tog, K1, P2, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P2, K1, P2tog, K1, P1 P2tog, K1, P1 P2tog, K1  
(24 Stitches)
16. P2, P2tog, K1, P2tog, P2, K1, P2, K1, P2tog, P2tog, K1, P2tog, K1, P2tog,, K1 (18 Stitches)
17. P3, K1, P3, K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1
18. K2tog, repeat until the end of the row (9 Stitches)
19. K2tog, K3tog, K2tog, K2tog (4 Stitches)

## Finishing

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- Cut the wool leaving around a 5cm tail. Pull it through the remaining stitches and feed through the hole at the top of the hat and pull tight.
- Turn the hat inside out. Sew in the finishing tail closing any hole that may still be at the top.
- Sew in the CO line.

With the green wool. Crochet a chain of 4 to 6 stitches, this is dependent on the thickness of the wool and also how long you would like the stem to be. Sew it onto the top of the hat.
